

Dad, I want to first say that I don't know if this e-mail will be received but I have sought Father about this and feel it has to be done. However, I am writing this in Love & with Pure Intentions. I have no strife or bitterness but do have concerns. I love you Dad but I **do not** love you more than God. I want to say thank you for teaching me the Word. You have taught me to Speak the Truth in Love and not to fear men's faces. Thus, I feel it is my duty to bring you the Word. I am concerned for the condition of your church. I know that recently you have felt that your congregation is struggling Spiritually. There seems to be a lot of hurting and confused members in your church. Why is this? What do you think is going on that makes people not want to be there or confused about what decisions to make. Do you think that the people are walking out there on Salvation, or are they Hypocritically following mandated rules? Are they searching the Scriptures for themselves and looking to the Holy Spirit for guidance, or are they just doing what they are told? Pure doctrine and counsel is necessary, but each individual needs to make their own personal decision and choice to follow Christ.

Or do you think that your church is in the shape it is in because you have been hiding Achan's Wedge of Gold? Is the SIN that you and your leadership hiding causing the leaven in your midst, as 1 Cor. 5: 1-13 speaks of? Recently, you said that there was leaven in your midst and for everyone to sharpen their javelins. You also said that you had a heavy burden and that you weren't going to point any fingers, YOU WHERE THE MAN. Is your church in the same condition as in 1 Cor. 5? I love you and everyone at Calvary and I know that it would be freeing to you and a lot of your members if you humbled yourself and came to the light with the TRUTH. I don't want you to find yourself in Matthew 7, there is so much in this chapter but these verses stand out to me: **Matthew 7: 22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? 23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.** And in 1 Corinthians 9:27 **27 But I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.**

Dad, you lied and told me & Kimberly 18 years ago that Lori & one other person took their clothes off for you one time. I don't know what you told Mom but I know she was thinking about leaving you? I know that you told all of us not to say anything because we would lose the church, the house and all the money. I also know that upon marrying Greer, your former Pastor, Dave Joyner's family wrote you about your Sin and you Lying about some of the miracles you had done. Richard Miller received the message and you meet with all the Pastors at that time. I don't know what was said to them. But, Forgive me for concealing your Sin and not loving you with the Truth of Gods Word. But, I recently found out the REAL TRUTH.

DAD, YOU MOLESTED YOUR NIECE'S, LORI AND DEBBIE ALMOST DAILY FOR THREE YEARS. IT STARTED WHEN LORI WAS 11 YEARS OLD (Hailey's Age) WHEN MOM WAS IN THE HOSPITAL GIVING BIRTH TO KIMBERLY. YOU USED TO WAIT OUTSIDE THEIR HOUSE IN YOUR GTO, UNTIL THEY GOT HOME FROM SCHOOL. YOU WERE GOING BACK AND FORTH BETWEEN THEIR BEDROOMS WHILE UNCLE JACK AND AUNT PEGGY WERE AT WORK. YOU WERE NAKED, LAYING THEM NAKED ON THEIR BEDS, INSERTING YOUR FINGERS INSIDE THEM AND MAKING THEM TOUCH YOU UNTIL YOU EJACULATED ON THEIR STOMACHS. YOU WERE

THEIR UNCLE & YOUTH PASTOR AT GREENFIELD ASSEMBLY OF GOD. IT ALSO CONTINUED HERE IN HERNDON, VA WHEN YOU WERE THE YOUTH PASTOR AT HERNDON ASSEMBLY.

THEY WERE JUST INNOCENT CHILDREN AND YOU ABUSED YOUR POWER AND AUTHORITY. NOT ONLY IS THIS SIN BUT IT IS A FELONY. THERE IS NO STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS FOR INCEST, CHILD MOLESTATION AND THESE TYPES OF CRIME. YOU COULD GO TO PRISON. HAVE YOU DONE THIS TO ANYONE ELSE?

The Bible clearly states what needs to be done in this situation and that there should be remuneration for what you have done to them and those affected by your Sin. How could you do this to them and speak derogatory of them and say how messed up they are. You caused most of their hurt and problems? How could you do this and say you and never had any problems and regrets in your marriage? The Bible is clear about what you should do with your Pastoral Role. I love you and know that if you Humble yourself, Truly Repent and Clear yourself by making things right. You will be free from this burden you speak of. I am concerned for your salvation and the condition of your church. See 1 Cor. 5 Below!!! Is this where your church is?

1 Corinthians 5

1 IT IS actually reported that there is sexual immorality among you, impurity of a sort that is condemned and does not occur even among the heathen; for a man has [his own] father's wife. ^(A)

2 And you are proud and arrogant! And you ought rather to mourn (bow in sorrow and in shame) until the person who has done this [shameful] thing is removed from your fellowship and your midst!

3 As for my attitude, though I am absent [from you] in body, I am present in spirit, and I have already decided and passed judgment, as if actually present,

4 In the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, on the man who has committed such a deed. When you and my own spirit are met together with the power of our Lord Jesus,

5 You are to deliver this man over to Satan ^[a] for physical discipline [to destroy carnal lusts which prompted him to incest], that [his] spirit may [yet] be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.

6 [About the condition of your church] your boasting is not good [indeed, it is most unseemly and entirely out of place]. Do you not know that [just] a little leaven will ferment the whole lump [of dough]?

7 Purge (clean out) the old leaven that you may be fresh (new) dough, still uncontaminated [as you are], for Christ, our Passover [Lamb], has been sacrificed.

8 Therefore, let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, nor with leaven of vice and malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened [bread] of purity (nobility, honor) and sincerity and [unadulterated] truth. ^(B)

9I wrote you in my [previous] letter not to associate [closely and habitually] with unchaste (impure) people--

10Not [meaning of course that you must] altogether shun the immoral people of this world, or the greedy graspers and cheats and thieves or idolaters, since otherwise you would need to get out of the world and human society altogether!

11But now I write to you not to associate with anyone who bears the name of [Christian] brother if he is known to be guilty of immorality or greed, or is an idolater [whose soul is devoted to any object that usurps the place of God], or is a person with a foul tongue [railing, abusing, reviling, slandering], or is a drunkard or a swindler or a robber. [No] you must not so much as eat with such a person.

12What [business] of mine is it and what right have I to judge outsiders? Is it not those inside [the church] upon whom you are to pass disciplinary judgment [passing censuring sentence on them as the facts require]?

13God alone sits in judgment on those who are outside. Drive out that wicked one from among you [expel him from your church].
